### COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course introduces students to the essential grammar and translation principles of the Holy Qur'ān. It aims to build a strong understanding of Qur'anic Arabic grammar, focusing on the basic rules and structures necessary for accurate interpretation. Students will learn fundamental grammatical concepts, including noun and verb forms, sentence structure and syntactic relationships.

Key topics include:

- Introduction to Qur'anic Arabic grammar
- Basic syntax and sentence construction
- Vocabulary development and key terms
- Translating Qur'anic verses and phrases
- Understanding context and meaning in Qur'anic text
