COURSE RATIONALE

“Inculcate the habit of reading the Holy Qur'an in the children and you should recite (the Holy Qur'an) as well. Every household should echo with the recitation of the Holy Qur'an. After it, try to read the translation” (Mash'ale-Rāh, Vol. V, pg. 119).

This course aims to cultivate a profound connection with the Holy Qur'an through the memorisation of selected Qur'anic prayers including the prayers of the prophets. By focusing on memorising these prayers and delving into their meanings, the course intends to foster a deeper spiritual connection in children. This approach aims to cultivate regular recitation and understanding of these prayers, enriching spiritual lives and integrating the essence of the Holy Qur'an in daily routines.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Holy Qur'an is the word of Allah the Exalted which He revealed to the Holy Prophet Muhammad^{saw} in piecemeal. The believers are instructed in light of the practice of the Holy Prophet^{saw} to recite the Holy Qur'an not only in the daily prayers but also outside of them. We find several narrations through the Sunnah of the Holy Prophet^{saw} that he used to recite various verses and chapters in his prayers. In fact, it was the practical demonstration of the command of the Holy Qur'an which we find abundantly in the life of the Holy Prophet^{saw} and his devoted companions.

This course is designed to help students age 7-15, memorise *Ad'iyatul-Qur'an* (Qur'anic prayers) with English translation. The primary objective is to enable students to recite these prayers during prayers and other moments of spiritual reflection, including Zikr-e-Ilahi. Envisioned to deepen children's connection with the Holy Qur'an, this course revolves around memorising selected Qur'anic prayers, including those attributed to the esteemed prophets. Memorising and reciting the prayers of the prophets enriches spiritual lives, deepens understanding, and allows individuals to emulate their devoutness, seeking guidance and drawing closer to the divine through their revered words.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of this course, students will be able to:

- recite the Qur'anic prayers including the prayers of the prophets with translation.
- demonstrate deeper knowledge of the background and history of each prayer covered.
- appreciate and understand as to which prayer should be recited during certain circumstances, along with developing a sense of approach.
- maintain and improve memory sharpness and increase intelligence and mental fortitude.
- cultivate the habit of *Zikr-e-Ilahi*, or remembrance of Allah.
