COURSE DESCRIPTION

Memorising the Holy Qur'an, especially the last part, holds immense significance in Islāmic tradition. Juz 'Amma contains chapters that are frequently recited in daily prayers and hold essential moral, ethical, and spiritual lessons. It serves as a cornerstone for deepening one's connection with the Qur'an and the teachings of Islām.

This course is designed to delve into the revered practice of memorising the last part (Juz 'Amma) of the Holy Qur'an. Students will embark on a transformative journey, delving deep into the significance of Qur'anic memorisation and its profound impact on personal, spiritual, and intellectual growth.

In this course, students will be able to memorise the last part of the Holy Qur'an. This course will be offered twice per week. Oral tests will be taken upon the completion of "Ruba". Simple Arabic Script of the Holy Qur'an will be used for memorisation, which contains 20 pages in a part/juz. (17 lines per page). Half of the last part will be covered in each semester (18-19 weeks long semester)

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon completion of this course, students should be able to:

- Accurately and fluently recite the last part of the Holy Qur'an from memory observing basic rules of nazirah
- cultivate a stronger spiritual connection with the Qur'an through memorisation.
- develop discipline, perseverance, and patience throughout the memorisation process, enhancing personal character and strengthening memory skills.
