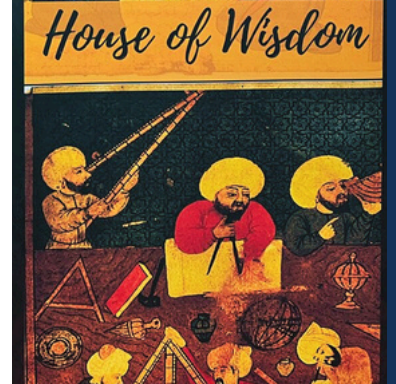
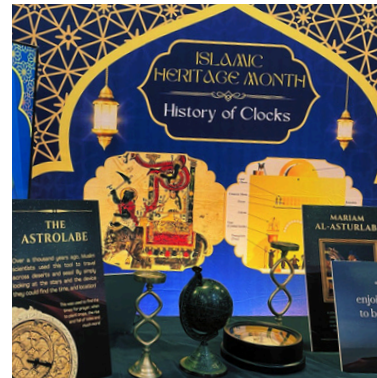
**"I enjoyed the calligraphy centre. I did not know how my name was spelled in urdu [before].**

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## COURSE SPOTLIGHT:

### HOLY QUR'AN TRANSLATION & GRAMMAR

This course introduces students to the fundamentals of Qur'anic Arabic grammar and translation. Focusing on basic grammar rules, sentence structure, and vocabulary, it equips students with the skills needed for accurate interpretation. Topics include noun and verb forms, syntax, and translating simple verses. Through a mix of theory and practical exercises, students will learn to translate Qur'anic text while understanding its context. By the end, they will have a solid foundation in grammar and translation, preparing them for advanced study.

### ISLĀMIC TEACHINGS OF FIQH

This course offers an introduction to the principles and practices of Islamic law drawn from the Holy Qur'an, Sunnah, Ahādīth, and the words of the Promised Messiah(as). Students will explore key topics such as the importance and obligations of prayer, its timings and conditions, and the proper method of performing it. Additionally, the course covers important areas of Islamic law, including marriage, divorce, children's rights, and inheritance. Designed to provide a well-rounded understanding, this course also highlights the relevance of Islamic law in addressing contemporary issues, helping students gain both a foundational and practical perspective.

'**Aisha Academy Canada** offers flexible study options for those interested in pursuing the **Mubashira Diploma in Islamic Theology and Comprehensive Studies** (3-year program) or a **Certificate in Fundamental Islamic Studies** (1-year program) available in both full-time and part-time formats. Students also have the option to take individual courses as part-time learners without working towards a certificate or diploma. To accommodate various schedules, these **online** courses are offered both in the mornings and evenings, with some courses available in Urdu. Whatever your goals may be, we have an option to suit your needs. All Ahmadi women who have completed their high school education can apply.

**Girls' Hifzul Qur'an School** is offering 4 online short evening courses for young Ahmadi girls across Canada to get a taste of Hifz. Memorize and understand parts of the Holy Qur'an, prayers, and more. Each girl can take up to 2 courses, and may select from two different timings for flexibility. All Ahmadi girls across Canada, ages 7-15 may apply. Age requirements may differ depending on the course.

## Courses Offered:

### Journey to Juz 'Amma

This course focuses on memorizing the last part of the Holy Qur'an, with an emphasis on correct recitation (Tarteel). Each semester covers a quarter of the last para, helping students achieve precision and excellence in reciting from memory.

Age Requirement: 9 - 15

### Hifz Al Qaseeda

Students will memorize the Arabic Qaseeda, a revered eulogy composed by the Promised Messiah (as) in honor of the Holy Prophet (sa). Memorizing this Qaseeda is believed to deepen love for the Prophet (sa) and bring spiritual rewards.

Age Requirement: 7 - 15

### Salaat Secrets

Students will memorize selected Qur'anic verses recited by Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V (aa) during congregational prayers, enabling them to recite these verses from memory in Salaat with proficiency.

Age Requirement: 9 - 15

### Hifz Al-Adi'ya

This course helps students memorize various prayers and their English translations while exploring their historical background and significance. It fosters cognitive development and a deeper appreciation for prayer and remembrance of Allah (Zikr-e-Ilahi).

Age Requirement: 7 - 15
