### COURSE DESCRIPTION

Ahadīth are the collection of the sayings, traditions, and the example of the Holy Prophet Muhammad<sup>saw</sup>, serving as a crucial source of guidance and wisdom for Muslims. This course aims to familiarize students with the teachings of the Prophet <sup>saw</sup> as it aims to develop an in-depth introduction to the science of ḥadīth (tradition), focusing on its terminology, foundational texts, and methodologies. Students will explore the significance of Ḥadīth as the second source of Islamic Legislation, complementing and elucidating the teachings of the Holy Qur'ān. The curriculum covers various aspects of the science of Ḥadīth, including terminology, prominent books, the lives of narrators, the etiquettes of narration, the conditions for transmitting knowledge, methodologies, modes of delivery, and associated peripheral issues. Through this exploration, students will gain a comprehensive understanding of the rigorous process behind authenticating and interpreting Ahaḍīth.
